- 1) 7/1/2024 Heat Pump Program Changes REMINDER: We made several changes to our heat pump program, effective 7/1/2024. The highlights are that we:
 - **a.** Dropped the thermostat cover requirement.
 - **b.** Switched from the CEE database to a list of eligible heat pump outdoor units that's easy to read and excludes dual-fuel and multi-zone heat pumps. Rebate eligibility is now based solely on the outdoor unit.
 - c. Specified that heating capacities be rated at dry bulb (DB) temperatures to match the ASHRAE design temperatures (for claims submitted after 12/31/2024).

- 2) 7/1/2024 Weatherization Program Updates REMINDER: We recently made a few small changes to our Weatherization Requirements Checklist. We also removed the Natural Gas Service Provider field from the rebate claim form because this information is not currently required. These changes went into effect on 7/1/2024.

- 5) **Rebate Processing Tip** The cost of heat pump warranties, boiler/furnace/tank removal, and any other costs directly related to a heat pump installation can be included in the total rebate-eligible project cost (see page 3 of the heat pump rebate claim form).
- 6) Fact of the Month We're continually investing in weatherization and are spending roughly a million dollars a year on print and radio advertising. This results in about 50 million impressions per year. We hope this helps drive demand.

- 7) **Tool of the Month** We have a new list of rebate-eligible heat pumps. Rebate-eligible heat pumps must have one of the outdoor units that appear on this list.




Number of Whole-Home Heat Pump Rebates by rebate category*




Nearly 100,000 Homes Have Received Heat Pump Rebates (shown by rebate category)*


